

# ENGINEERING NEWS-RECORD (ENR) 2009 RANKINGS

ENR attempts to bring structure to an otherwise huge and chaotic industry by performing annual surveys and ranking companies engaged in general contracting, specialty contracting, engineering, architecture, planning and studies. The rankings are based on annual revenue at home and abroad and are further divided into specific market categories.

## The Top 100 Design/Build Firms

The Top 100 Design/Build Firms list, published annually in June, ranks the 100 largest U.S. design/build firms, both publicly and privately held, based on revenue derived from projects delivered using the design/build project delivery system.

**Kinsley was ranked 68th in 2009, up 16 spots from our 2008 ranking of 84th.**

## The Top 400 Contractors

With the economy in recession and the market in decline, many large contractors are thankful that 2008 was booming, giving them one last chance to build backlogs. The ENR Top 400 Contractors raked in \$338.38 billion in contracting revenue in 2008, up 11.2% over the \$304.36 billion that the Top 400 took in during 2007. Of 375 contractors on this year's list that submitted surveys last year, 245 had revenue increases, 128 saw declines and two were virtually unchanged.

**Kinsley moved up 8 spots into the 152nd ranking in 2009, up from 160th in 2008.**
